Eligibility criteria:

Applicants should have a minimum Second-Class Honors Upper Division Degree in the discipline of mathematics, statistics, economics, computer science and other related disciplines from any recognized Institution.




Documents Required for Application:

- A cover letter indicating for which program of study the application is being made and description of the motivation to join the program
- A curriculum vitae (CV)
- Notarized Bachelor's degrees and transcripts
- Recommendation letters from at least two academic referees who are knowledgeable about the applicant.
- Support letter from employer (if any).
- Copies of valid identification card and/or passport.
- Sponsorship letter from an organization (if any).
- Applicants from countries where English is not the medium of instruction must provide an English proficiency certificate from a relevant body or institution in their respective countries.
- A proof of payment of non-refundable application fee 10,000RWF (12\$) for nationals and members of East African Community (EAC) and 12,000 RWF (14\$) for other. Payment Instructions:
