1. GRADUATION DATE

Jaramogi Oginga Odinga University of Science and Technology wishes to inform ALL candidates who qualified for the conferment of various degrees and award of diplomas and certificates of Jaramogi Oginga Odinga University of Science and Technology in the 2023/2024 Academic Year, that the 12th Graduation Ceremony will take place on **Friday 18th OCTOBER 2024** starting from 8.30am at the Main Campus, Bondo. All Graduands and guests should be seated by 8.00 am. All those students who would qualify for graduation are informed as follows:

2. VERIFICATION OF NAMES

- All prospective graduands are advised to liaise with their respective Deans of schools to confirm BY if their names are in the graduation list and also ensure the correctness of their names as would be desirable in the certificates from 17th September 2024.
- The correct order of names is: (Surname/Family Name) (First name) (Other names)

Note: Initials not allowed. Note that after the certificates have been printed out, requests for changes in the order of names will attract a penalty.

3. FEE PAYMENT

TUITION FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

Prospective graduands should ensure that they have cleared all fees and charges owed to the University. Only those who have cleared all fees and any other charges will be included in the graduation list and be allowed to graduate.

GRADUATION FEE

Graduands will be required to pay a non-refundable graduation fee as indicated below:

- ❖ PhD Kshs.6,000/ ❖ Masters Kshs.5,000/ ❖ Bachelors Kshs.4,000/-
- Diploma Kshs.3,500/-
- Certificate Kshs.3,000/-

4. FILLING OF CLEARANCE FORMS

- ❖ It is a mandatory requirement for students to fill the official clearance forms ONLINE. The clearance forms are available in the student's portal for students who have successfully cleared their studies and paid full fees and all other charges.
- Candidates who had completed their studies **previously** but could not graduate in previous graduation ceremonies are expected to apply for graduation upon clearing fees and meeting all other University requirements by filling the **graduation intent** form: REF: JOOUST/RAA/G/F.45. This form plus fee statement signed by Finance Office should reach the Registrar Academic and Student Affairs.
