RE: IMPORTANT ACADEMIC INFORMATION TO STUDENTS ON EXAMINATIONS

Reference is made to our letter dated 1st February, 2021, which advised students to provisionally move to the next year of study pending processing and approval of examination results for the 2019/2020 Academic Year by the Senate. In this respect, while discussing these examination results, reference was made to STATUTE XLV of the University Statutes (2013) (amendment 2016) on examination regulations for Bachelors Degree and Diploma, clause 2 (b), (c) and (d) on examination results which state as follows:

- 1. Candidates who fail in not more than 25% of the courses registered for in the year be allowed to re-sit the courses failed when next offered (for as long as it is the first or second fail/re-sit). You may however proceed to the next level of study.
- 2. Candidates who have failed a re-sit examination the second time be allowed to re-take the courses when next offered.
- 3. Candidates who fail more than 25% but less than 50% of the courses registered for in the year to retake the courses when next offered; Retake means you go back to class and repeat the course, learn again, sit for both CAT and end semester exam before proceeding to the next level of study.
- 4. Candidates who fail more than 50% of the courses registered to be discontinued.
- 5. Candidates who are unable to take examinations for reasons acceptable to Senate be allowed to take special examinations.

However, taking cognizance of these provisions against the environment in which these examinations were undertaken with respect to the debilitating effect of the COVID-19 pandemic, Senate advises that the affected students of the 2019/2020 Academic Year are allowed to sit for the respective failed/deferred course units as Re-sit/Special Examinations when next offered except in a case where a student is required to retake the course unit.

Any candidate who feels aggrieved and is convinced that he/ she uploaded the scripts but has found the name in the deferred list should feel free to report the same to respective School Deans not later than 30th March 2021.
